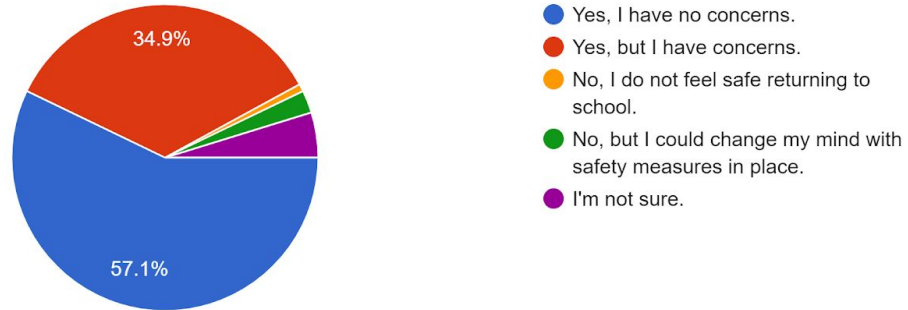
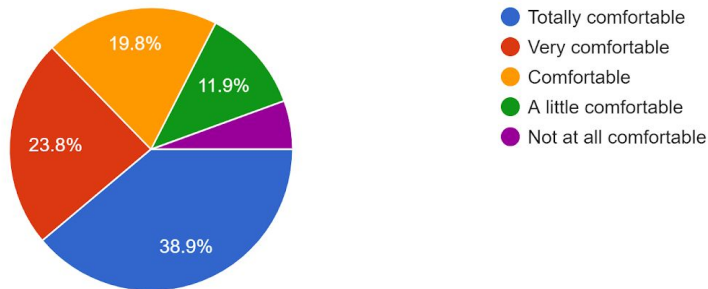

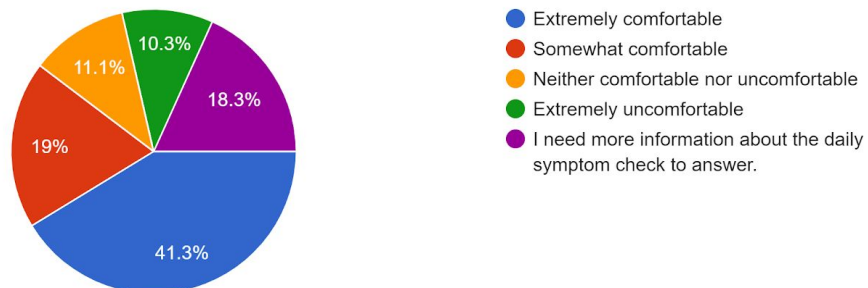
Should we receive guidance from local health authorities that it is safe to return to school with cautionary measures in place, will your child(ren) ...turning to your school for the 2020-21 school year?

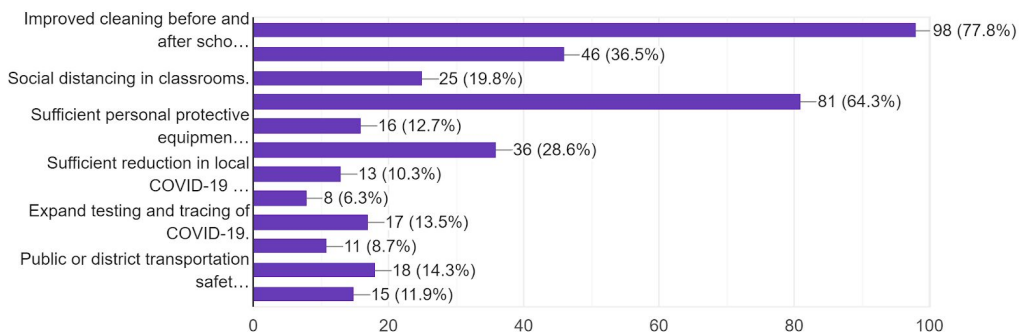

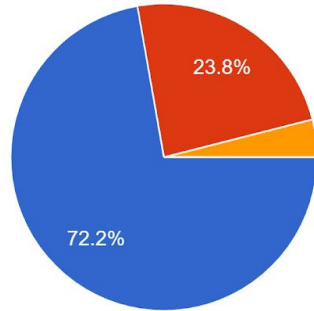

- Remote Learning Environment: Students would be doing all of their learning from home and not entering t...

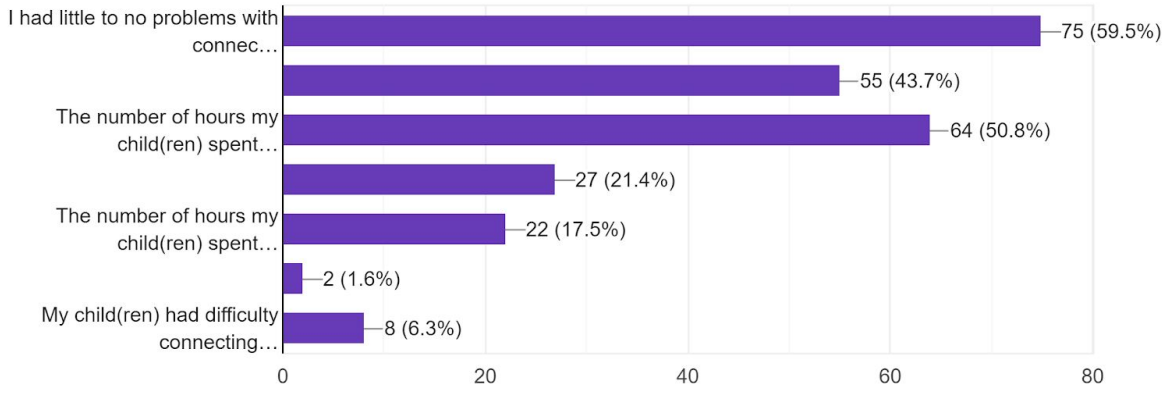

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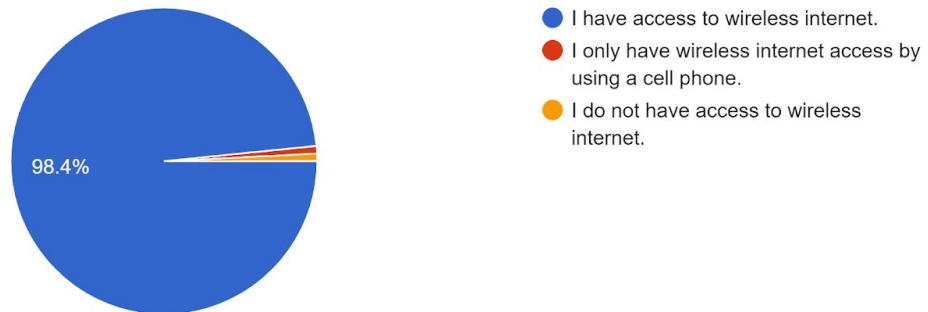
