UPDATED COVID GUIDELINES IF YOU TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID: ISOLATE EVERYONE, REGARDLESS OF VACCINATION STATUS:

- Stay home for at least 5 days.
- Fully isolate away from household contacts.
- Remain at home for as long as you have symptoms.
- Stay home until you are fever free for at least 24 hours, without the use of fever reducing medications.
- If you have no symptoms or your symptoms resolve, you can leave your house after a **minimum** of 5 days of isolation.
- Recommended wearing a mask around others for 5 additional days after you leave isolation.

If you have been exposed to covid:

IF YOU ARE VACCINATED:

IF YOU: Have been boosted

Or Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months

OR Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months

OR Have had a positive Covid test within the last 90 days

YOU SHOULD:

- Monitor symptoms for 10 days.
- If you develop symptoms at any time, get tested and stay home.
- Recommended you wear a mask around others for 10 days.

IF YOU ARE NOT FULLY VACCINATED:

IF YOU: Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine more than 6 months ago and are not boosted

OR Completed the primary series of J&J more than 2 months ago and are not boosted

OR Are unvaccinated

YOU SHOULD:

- Monitor symptoms for 10 days.
- If you develop symptoms at any time, get tested and stay home.
- Recommended you wear a mask around others for 10 days.
