The Board of Education of Unified School District Meeting Time and Place #467, Wichita County, Kansas met in special session at 7:00 p.m., Monday, August 22, 2022 at the Board of Education office. **People Present** 2. Members present were: Julee Beedy, Brian Gerstberger, Jesse Harbrige, Jason Koehn, Jim Myers, Ann Wiles, and Josh Young. Also present were: Superintendent, Lori Maxwell; Clerk, Tammy Mason; WCES Principal, Brant Douglas; WCJSHS Principal, Delbert Schmidt; Director of Maintenance/Transportation, Buck Bishop; and Guests: Andrea Bauck. Meeting Called to Order 3. Jim Myers called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. State Assessments 4. Superintendent Maxwell provided copies of the 2020-21 accountability report to the board and reviewed the state assessment scores. Each of the three subject areas of ELA, math and science were discussed. All students performing in Levels 1 and 2 were compared to student subgroups for free and reduced lunch students, students with disabilities, and Hispanic students. When compared to each subgroup, the All Students group outperformed each subgroup in all three subject areas. The most significant discrepancy was between students with disabilities and All Students with a 37.75% difference in ELA and a 19.77% difference in math. The Board had questions about the assessment analysis and explored ideas for closing the gap. In addition, a State Assessment Review for Budget Considerations was reviewed for the district level, WCES, and WCJSHS. At each level, as evidenced by the state assessment review documents, the board identified barriers that must be overcome for each student to achieve grade level proficiency on state assessments, budget actions to address and remove barriers, and the timeline it will take for each student to achieve grade level proficiency on state

assessments. The building needs assessment, which is also part of the budget adoption process, was reviewed and discussed at the August 8, 2022 regular board meeting. Maxwell reported the needs assessments and state assessments documents are posted on the district website.
